National Vocational Qualifications are competency based qualifications which provide a means of evaluating individual skills or whole workforce skills. Staff with nationally recognised qualifications will enhance the competitiveness of your organisation.

We offer National Vocational Qualification Level 2, 3 & 4 in Health & Social Care, respectively. We also offer the Level 4 Care Management Award, which became a mandatory requirement for all registered managers from April 2005.

You can determine the most suitable level of NVQ, depending on the learner's job role and we would be more than happy to advise you further.

Health and Social Care NVQ Level 2



Who is it for?

This course has been specifically designed for Health and Social Care Workers. It is a nationally recognised qualification which can support and enable staff with their organisations care delivery practices.

What is the course about?

Providing core personal care by furthering individual career skills and organisations.

You must already be in a Health and Social Care environment to complete this course.

Course overview

- Each candidate is given a learning pack which includes a Workbook at induction.
- This award involves both direct care, where the focus is hands-on care (doing things for clients) and enablement care where the focus is on the development and maintenance of the client's independence.
- The candidate must complete 6 units, 4 core plus 2 optional.
- Your assessor will observe you in your care environment

- **Registration** - Registration with the awarding body and receive a full set of National Standards
- **Qualification** – A nationally recognised qualification.
- **Practical Skills** – Increased knowledge, awareness and care skills.

What is the course about?

Providing greater responsibility and recognition of a high level of individual career skills.

You must already be in a Health and Social Care environment to complete this course.

- Each candidate is given a learning pack which includes a Workbook at induction
- This award is designed to be applicable to staff who deliver physical, emotional, or enabling care to clients who have a medium to high degree of dependency, whether they work in health or social care, or in the public, private or voluntary sectors.
- The candidate must complete 8 units, 4 core plus 4 optional.
- Your assessor will observe you in your care environment

Developing greater management skills in the allocation of resources and staff development.

You must already be in a Health and Social Care environment to complete this course.

Course overview

- The Award has links to NVQ level 4 management and the Registered Managers Award. It also links to NVQ level 3 in Health & Social Care.
- The candidate must complete 8 units, 4 core plus 4 optional.
- This award is applicable to candidates with a supervisory or management responsibility for other staff or autonomy in developing service responses to client needs.
- Your assessor will observe you in your care environment

What do I get out of it?

- **Registration** - Registration with the awarding body and receive a full set of National Standards
- **Qualification** – A nationally recognised qualification reflecting your competency level.
- **Management Skills** – Developing your skills and knowledge of a junior management role.

- The candidate must complete 8 units, 4 core plus 4 optional.
- Your assessor will observe you in your care environment
